Vic covered the federal definitions of evaluation, assessment, and continuous improvement. The requirements of 21CCLC through the state and federal regulations ensure that these definitions are met. Vic shared the measures of effectiveness for the state of Iowa: attendance, behavior, and academic improvements in reading and math. Vic also covered the local evaluation and encouraged Committee members to make sure goals are measureable. Objectives can be changed by working with Vic.
